

Privacy Policy

The Solet Committee ("we," "our," or "us") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our website (the "Site") or use our services. By accessing or using our Site, you consent to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

a. Personal Information

Information that identifies you as an individual, such as:

- Name
- Email address
- Phone number

- Payment information (if applicable)

You provide this information to us voluntarily when you fill out a contact form or purchase services from us.

b. Non-Personal Information

Information that does not directly identify you, such as:

- Browser type and version
- Operating system
- IP address
- Cookies and usage data

c. Information Collected Automatically

When you visit our Site, certain information is collected automatically, including:

- Your device's IP address
- Your geolocation (based on IP address)
- Pages viewed, time spent on pages, and clickstream data
- Referring website URLs

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- To provide and maintain our services.
- To process transactions and send confirmations.
- To communicate with you about your account or inquiries.
- To improve and personalize your user experience.
- To send promotional emails, newsletters, or other information (you can opt out at any time).
- To monitor and analyze trends, usage, and activities on our Site.
- To comply with legal obligations or enforce our terms and conditions.

3. Sharing Your Information

We may share your information with the following parties:

a. Service Providers

We may share information with third-party service providers who assist us in operating our business, such as payment processors, email service providers, or analytics providers.

b. Legal Compliance

We may disclose information to comply with legal obligations, such as responding to subpoenas, court orders, or legal processes.

c. Business Transfers

If we merge, sell, or transfer our business assets, your information may be transferred as part of the transaction.

d. With Your Consent

We retain your personal information only as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected or to comply with legal obligations. When your data is no longer needed, we will delete or anonymize it.

6. Your Rights

You have the following rights regarding your personal information:

Access: Request access to the information we hold about you.

Correction: Request corrections to any inaccurate or incomplete information.

Deletion: Request the deletion of your personal information.

Data Portability: Request a copy of your personal information in a portable format.

Opt-Out: Opt out of marketing communications or targeted advertising.

To exercise these rights, contact us.

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your information from unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or disclosure. However, no system is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

8. Third-Party Links

9. Children's Privacy

Our Site is not intended for children under the age of 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children. If we become aware that we have collected information from a child under 13, we will delete it promptly.
